Cadet Selection Criteria

Start date: 19 MAY 2018

End date: 23 MAY 2018

1. The cost will be \$175
2. Top priority will be given to seniors and juniors
3. Must be able to take off from school 21, 22, 23 MAY (School letters are available from the COTC)
4. Cadet must be 15 years or older
5. Must be a minimum of E5 or above at the time of the training (unless a junior or senior who started late in NSCC. In that case, you must scan & upload a copy of your Magellan Record Book)
6. Must have a recommendation from their unit CO listing that the cadet is in "Good Standing" with coursework, exams, attendance 75% or above, passed the PRT, outstanding uniform and military bearing, and any other accomplishments.
7. Participation in previous Fleet Weeks is a disqualifier
8. NO medical conditions including NO food allergies
9. Cadet MUST be able to take Dramamine.
10. Not claustrophobic
11. No prior inner-ear medical issues or other prior medical issues

Steps for Applying

STEP 1. Write a 300 word typed essay, "Why I Want to Go to Fleet Week"

STEP 2. Obtain a Letter of Recommendation from your unit Commanding Officer. If the CO is a relative, the recommendation should be written by the XO.

STEP 3. Complete with parental signatures **Fleet Week Embark** form. Leaving any spaces blank or lack of signatures will void your application.

STEP 4. Email **ASAP** LCDR Debbie Treacy dtreacy7@yahoo.com the following:

- Essay
- CO's Recommendation Letter
- Fleet Week Embark form
- Scanned copy of Cadet's Magellan Record Book

DEADLINE to complete STEPS 1-4: 14 APR 2018

If selected, you will receive a Welcome Package from LCDR D. Treacy with further directions. DO NOT register in Magellan. You must be selected FIRST!
